

**AGREED MINUTES
BETWEEN
THE AERONAUTICAL AUTHORITIES OF ICELAND
AND THE UNITED ARAB EMIRATES**

Delegations representing the Government of Iceland and the United Arab Emirates met in Punta Cana, Dominican Republic, at ICAN2025 on the 11th November 2025 to discuss matters relating to further development of the aviation relations between the two countries. The discussions were held in a cordial and friendly atmosphere. The list of the delegations is attached as Appendices A and B to this Agreed Minutes.

The two Delegations referred to Article 3 of the Air Services Agreement signed on 29 September 2015, and agreed as follows:

Designation

1. The Delegation of Iceland designated Flugfélagið Atlanta ehf., d/b/a Air Atlanta Icelandic and Icelandair ehf. as a Designated Airlines of Iceland to operate all air services under the Agreement. The Delegation of the UAE accepted the above airlines as designated by Iceland.
2. The Delegation of the UAE designated Air Arabia Abu Dhabi as a designated airline of the UAE to operate all services under the Agreement, in addition to the prior designation of Etihad Airways, Emirates Airline, flydubai and Air Arabia. The Delegation of Iceland accepted the above airline as designated by the UAE.

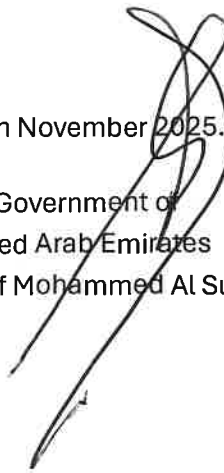
Both Delegations agreed the provisions of this Agreed Minutes shall come into force with immediate effect from the date of signature.
