AGREED MINUTES

ON AIR SERVICES

BETWEEN

THE AERONAUTICAL AUTHORITY GOVERNMENT OF ICELAND

AND THE AERONAUTICAL AUTHORITY OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED
MEXICAN STATES

1. Delegations representing the Government of Iceland and the Government of Mexico met in Punta Cana, Dominican Republic, at ICAN2025 on the 12th November 2025 in order to consult the exercise of Code Share provisions, as well as charter applications. A list of members of the two Delegations is attached as Annex I.
2. The discussions were conducted in a friendly and positive atmosphere and both Delegations stressed their interest in expanding mutual relations in the field of air transport.
3. Both Delegations agreed on the exercise of third and fourth freedom traffic rights and that the Aeronautical Authority of Iceland has the intention to designate Icelandair, then this has to be done by diplomatic channel in accordance of provisions of the Air Services Agreement.
4. The Mexican Delegation informed the Icelandic Delegation the process for the realizing Code Share and Charter operations.

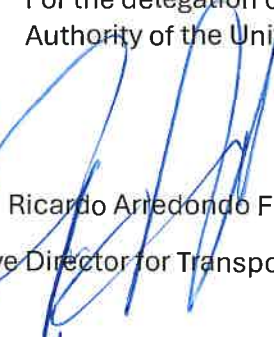
