

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
Between Jamaica and Iceland signed at JamaICAN2010

held at
The Ritz Carlton Golf and Spa Resort, Montego Bay, Jamaica
between June 27- July 02, 2010

The delegations representing the Government of Jamaica and Iceland (hereinafter referred to “Jamaica” and “Iceland” respectively or “Contracting Party” and collectively as the “Delegations” or “Contracting Parties”) met in Montego Bay, Jamaica on 1 July 2010 for consultations with a view to negotiating an air service agreement and related arrangements which would be applicable in respect of the operations of air transportation between and beyond their respective countries.

Discussions were held in a very friendly atmosphere. The composition of the two Delegations is attached as “Attachment A” and “Attachment B” respectively.

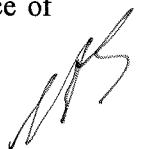
As a result of these discussions, the Delegations have reached the following agreements and conclusions:

1. TEXT OF THE AIR SERVICES AGREEMENT (ASA)

The text of the ASA and its Annexes attached hereto as “Attachment C” was agreed and initialed by the Heads of both Delegations.

As from the date of signature of this Memorandum of Understanding and until such time as the ASA and its Annexes shall come into force, the two Delegations agree to apply the principles included therein, on a provisional basis and within the scope of their administrative competencies.

Both Delegations undertook to take such steps as will lead to an early signature, and completion of their respective constitutional requirements for the entry into force of the ASA and its Annexes as soon as possible.



2 **AMENDMENTS OF THE ASA**

Amendments of the ASA shall be done following, when necessary, consultations between the aeronautical authorities of the Contracting Parties.

3 **FURTHER DISCUSSIONS REGARDING 7th FREEDOM RIGHTS WITH RESPECT TO PASSENGER AND MAIL**

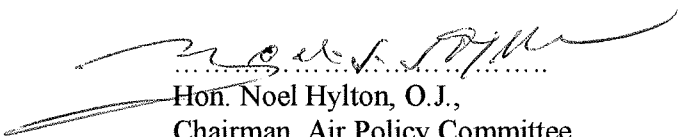
The Contracting Parties agreed, if the opportunity were to arise in future, to explore the possibility of agreeing to Seventh Freedom Rights with respect to passenger and mail.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall come into effect on the date of its signature.
