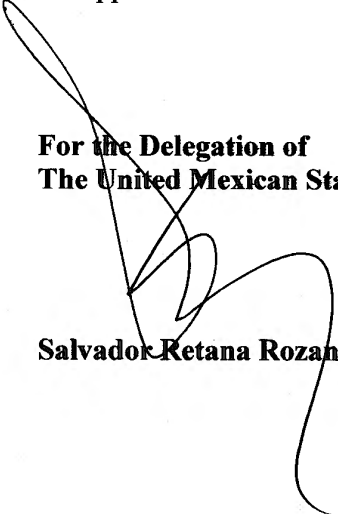


MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

**on Air Services
between the Government of Iceland
and the Government of the United States of Mexico**

1. Delegations representing the Government of Iceland and the Government of the United Mexican States met in Mumbai, India, during ICAO Air Services Negotiations Conference on 19 October 2011 in order to assess their bilateral air transport relations and to negotiate an admendment to their existing Air Services Agreement. A list of members of the two Delegations is attached as Annex 1.
2. The discussions were conducted in a friendly and positive atmosphere. In their effort to strengthen the relations between their respective Countries in the field of civil aviation, the Aeronautical Authorities of the United Mexican States and Iceland (Delegations) agreed that, their aeronautical authorities, in accordance with their domestic legislation, may issue the necessary administrative permits and authorizations in order that the airlines to be designated may operate air services with unlimited number of weekly frequencies in 3rd and 4th freedom traffic rights and capacity with any type of aircraft, for both passengers and all cargo services, pending the signature and subsequent entry into force of the Air Services Agreement signed in Mexico City on July 11, 2008.
3. The said Authorities further agree that, in addition to third and fourth freedom traffic rights, the Designated Airlines of each Contracting Party are entitled to exercise fifth freedom traffic rights with passenger or all cargo, only after consultations between the Civil Aviation Authorities of the parties and previous approval therof.
