

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

ON AIR SERVICES

BETWEEN

THE GOVERNMENT OF ICELAND

AND THE REPUBLIC OF ECUADOR

1. Delegations representing the Government of Iceland and the Aeronautical Authority of Ecuador met in Punta Cana, Dominican Republic, at ICAN2025 on the 11th November 2025 in order to assess their bilateral air transport relations and to negotiate an Air Services Agreement. A list of members of the two Delegations is attached as Annex I.
2. The discussions were conducted in a friendly and positive atmosphere and both Delegations stressed their interest in expanding mutual relations in the field of air transport.
3. The Icelandic delegation referred to agreed minutes between the two countries signed in Bali, Indonesia in 2014. The Delegation of Iceland proposed to send a new draft ASA for Ecuador to examine in a separate email.
4. Both delegations confirmed that in addition to full unrestricted third and fourth freedom traffic rights and that the Designated Airlines of each Contracting Party would be entitled to exercise full unrestricted fifth freedom traffic rights at all points (whether intermediate or beyond points) of their own choice while operating any type of services (passenger and/or cargo, separately or in combination) pending on the conclusion on the Air Services Agreement. Additionally, the Icelandic Delegation requested entitlement to exercise, in all-cargo services only, full seventh freedom traffic rights.
5. In their effort to strengthen the relations between their respective Countries in the field of civil aviation, the Delegations agreed the provisions of this MOU shall come into force with immediate effect from the date of signature. In their effort to strengthen the relations between the two countries the Delegation agreed that the Aeronautical Authorities of both Parties would be in contact in order to finalise an agreement in near future.
