

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Delegations representing the Government of Iceland and the Government of the United Arab Emirates (hereinafter referred to "Iceland" and "the UAE" respectively, and collectively as the "Delegations") met in Nairobi, Kenya, on 12 and 13 December 2018 for the purpose of discussing ASA arrangements which are applicable in respect of the operations of air transportation between and beyond their respective countries.

Discussions were held in a very friendly atmosphere. The composition of the two Delegations is attached as "Attachment A" and "Attachment B" respectively.

The two Delegations referred to Article 3 of the Air Services Agreement which was signed on 29 September 2015, and agreed as follows:

Designation

- a) The Delegation of the UAE designated Emirates Airline, Etihad Airways, Air Arabia and flydubai as Designated Airlines of the United Arab Emirates. Additional UAE airline(s) may be designated in due course by the Aeronautical Authority of the UAE. The Delegation of Iceland accepted the above airlines as designated by the UAE.
- (b) The Delegation of Iceland designated Icelandair, Wow Air, Air Atlanta and Bluebird Cargo as Designated Airlines of Iceland. Additional Icelandic airline(s) may be designated in due course by the Aeronautical Authority of Iceland. The Delegation of UAE accepted the above airlines as designated by Iceland.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall come into effect on the date of its signature.

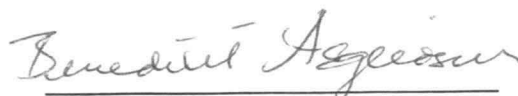
